

# RUBBER CRUMB (F, M, C) LOST CIRCULATION MATERIAL

**RUBBER CRUMB** is a lost circulation material (LCM) made up of vulcanized rubber ground available in 3 sizes: Fine, Medium and Coarse.

# FEATURES AND BENEFITS:

- Used as a seepage loss, LCM and bridging agent for all drilling fluid systems.
- Chemically-inert.
- May be added to any water- or oil-based fluid.
- Will deform under pressure and can be squeezed into fractures or voids: will then return to its original shape and size.
- This physical feature enables it to provide an effective and lasting seal.

**RECOMMENDED TREATMENT:** 20-80 kg/m<sup>3</sup> (typically)
